Objective:

Give Shooters the tools to effectively engage in targets with a precision rifle systems and optics out to 1250 yards, to include known distance, unknown distance, rapid engagements and alternate positions.

Day 1:

- Fundamental Evaluation
- Overview of the fundamentals of Marksmanship
- Introduction to optics
- Rifle setup
- Scope set up – level, eye relief and adjusting parallax
- Introduction to ballistics
- Ballistic software Hornady 4DOF / TRSAOL

Range:

- Body position and trigger control
- Zero / Grouping exercise
- Chronograph use
- True ballistics systems for muzzle velocity
- Target engagements 25 – 1125 yards
- Weapons cleaning

Day 2:

- Reticle Use
- Wind Reading
- Data Collection

Range:

- Milling exercise
- Target engagements using mil relation formula to 800 yards
- Known distance target engagements 200 – 1250 yards
- Confirming data and software

- Data Collection Review
- Shooter's Choice topics

Range:

- Target engagements utilizing holds 300 – 800 yards
- Tripods and other supported positions
- Barricades
- Open Range shoot to distance to end class
